Tuesday Night Athletic Foundation Hosts Second Beach Open Water Challenge

On September 12, 2009, the Tuesday Night Athletic Foundation (TNAF) is proud to host its second annual Second Beach Open Water Challenge in conjunction with the New England Open Water Championships at Sachuest Beach in Middletown, RI. This unique fundraising event consists of a one-mile open water swim to raise money for amateur athletes and will feature some of the best competition that the east coast has to offer. Building on the successes of last year's Open Water Challenge, TNAF is expecting a turnout of close to 400 swimmers, competing in different "waves." An elite wave will showcase some of the fastest open water swimmers in all of New England. The popular Masters wave is open to anyone registered with US Masters Swimming, with ages spanning from athletes in their twenties up to those in their seventies and older. Additionally, the college and USS waves will give younger athletes from around New England the opportunity to compete in this exciting event. One of the major highlights of the day will come with the final wave - an "anything that floats" race. Entrants will paddle their boards, kayaks, canoes, and other floating objects in a fun race through the surf to wrap up the competition.



Following the morning's competition, TNAF will host an awards ceremony and present over 60 awards to the top athletes from each age group and category.
